5. Devi's Fall (Patale Chhango): A unique and powerful waterfall just 2 km from Pokhara Airport, Devi's Fall disappears into an underground tunnel. Its beauty and mysterious origin make it a popular stop for visitors.
6. Gupteshwor Mahadev Cave: Located in Chhorepatan of Pokhara, the cave lies opposite Devi's Fall. This sacred cave is one of Nepal's longest and oldest. Inside, you'll find a shrine dedicated to Lord Shiva, along with impressive limestone formations.
7. World Peace Pagoda (Shanti Stupa): Sitting atop Anadu Hill, this white pagoda offers stunning views of Pokhara, Phewa Lake, and the surrounding mountains. It's a peaceful place ideal for reflection and photography. It is the first peace pagoda in the world and the 71st pagoda built by Nipponzan-Myōhōji.
8. Phewa Lake: The second-largest lake in Nepal, Phewa Lake is a top attraction in Pokhara. You can enjoy a peaceful boat ride and visit the Barahi Temple, located on a small island in the middle of the lake.

What are the historical sites and ancient temples inside Kathmandu Valley?

Kathmandu Valley is well-renowned for its numerous historical sites, including seven World UNESCO Heritage Sites. Often known as “the Valley of Temples,” the city has countless temples inside its valley. Here are some of the historical sites and temples inside Kathmandu:

Kathmandu Durbar Square

Located at the center of the Kathmandu Valley, Kathmandu Durbar Square is also known as Hanuman Dhoka and Basantapur Durbar Square. Its intricate wood carvings and rich history make it a must-visit destination in the city. The Durbar Square has more than 50 temples on its premises, thus named the “Museum of Temple.” Moreover, it was the royal palace of the Malla Kings and later the Shah Dynasty.

Patan Durbar Square

The Patan Durbar Square is a visually appealing display of Newari architecture in Nepal, located in the Lalitpur District. It showcases the architectural and aesthetic excellence of the Malla Dynasty from the 12th to the 18th century in the Kathmandu Valley. Further, Durbar Square is home to the Patan Museum, which showcases unique ancient architecture.

Bhaktapur durbar Square

Bhaktapur Durbar Square is another World UNESCO Heritage Site in the Bhaktapur District of Kathmandu Valley. It was the former royal palace of Malla Kings from the 14th to 15th century and is now managed by the Archeological Department of Nepal and Bhaktapur Municipality. Likewise, Bhaktapur Durbar Square is known as the best-preserved of the three Durbar Squares of the Kathmandu Valley.

Swayambhunath Stupa

Swayambhu means ‘self-sprung’ or ‘self-manifested’ in Nepali Bhasa. The Stupa is one of the holiest sites at the top of Green Hill and is also known as Monkey Temple. It is believed to be 2500 years old and holds great religious and spiritual significance. The Stupa’s large dome with the four eyes of Buddha and a thirteen-level golden spire is the key attraction of the landmark.

Boudhanath Stupa

Located on the eastern outskirts of Kathmandu Valley, Boudhanath Stupa is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and the largest spherical Stupa in the world. The Stupa is a prominent pilgrimage site for Buddhists and symbolizes enlightenment and peace. The large white dome with Buddha’s all-seeing eye attracts travelers. Visitors can circumambulate the Stupa while spinning a prayer wheel, gaining spiritual knowledge and a common practice for visitors.

Pashupatinath Temple

Pashupatinath is the most sacred and holiest Hindu Temple in Kathmandu Valley, located at the bank of the Bagmati River. Built on an area of 246 hectares, the premises of Pashupati has 518 mini-temples and

a main pagoda-style temple. The temple holds religious significance to Indian and Nepali Hindus and is also a significant place for Hindu's cremation ritual. Thus, visitors can witness unique funeral ceremonies during the Pashupatinath visit.

You'll arrive in Nagarkot by evening, just in time to enjoy a beautiful sunset over the distant Himalayan peaks. Overnight stay at a hotel in Nagarkot.
