06:00 AM: Pick up from the hotel and transfer to the domestic airport.

07:00 AM: Fly to Muktinath by a chartered Helicopter.

Muktinath Temple is located in 1 hour flying distance from Kathmandu.

Flight highly depends upon the weather.

Enjoy the panoramic snowcapped mountain views.

Arrival at Muktinath and 1 hour ground time for darshan.

Short walk and reach Muktinath Temple.

Take bath on 108 chilled holy waterspouts and two Holy Kunda.

Change clothes and perform a pooja at the temple.

Back to the helipad.

Fly back to Kathmandu.

Arrival and drop to your hotel.

FAQ's

Are there any weight limits on the flight?

The helicopter can accommodate a maximum of 5 pax excluding pilots. On group group-sharing basis helicopter will depart with the minimum requirement of 3 Pax. On a charter basis helicopter can accommodate up to 5 Pax.

Is there an age limit while travelling in a Helicopter?

There is no age barrier to experiencing this trip. But in the case of children, children above 3 years old can be eligible for helicopter tours. All age groups can experience a helicopter tour.

Are Helicopter flights affected by weather conditions?

Mountain weather is often unpredictable. It highly depends upon morning temperature and wind on the very same day. We would suggest you make your traveling dates flexible between 3 to 4 days in order to avoid bad weather. If the flight is affected due to weather you can try the next day.
